- [Day 190: Hamas Hostage Profile: Daniella Gilboa, 19](#)



For several months, Daniella Gilboa's family heard nothing of her condition. She was an unarmed observation soldier at the IDF 414th Combat Intelligence Collection Unit Nahal Oz base. She had sent videos to her boyfriend that day that showed what she was wearing. When Hamas videos appeared later in the day showing three of Gilboa's friends being taken hostage to Gaza, her family identified her by the shirt she was wearing and a small, hidden ponytail on her head. It wasn't until seven weeks later, on January 26th that they had confirmation that she was being held by Hamas when the terror group published a propaganda video of her, Karina Arieiev, and Doron Steinbrecher. Her family felt relief at the proof of life, but is still reserved regarding her condition. Daniella's mother, Orly, explains how "until that cursed day [October 7], Daniella was called Daniel. But after consulting with a rabbi, her family added the Hebrew letter "heh" to her name. Mrs. Gilboa also shared that her youngest daughter, Noam, 15, now sleeps in Daniella's bed every night to 'feel her' adored older sibling.

Guy Gilboa-Dalal was taken hostage by Hamas terrorists on October 7th from the Supernova rave. It was Guy's first rave, something that he'd been planning with his friends Idan Hermati, Ron Zarfati, and Eviatar David for months beforehand. His older brother, Gal, drove to the festival early that morning, reaching the site at 5:30 a.m. The two brothers met up, hugged, and took a selfie, which Guy sent to their mother. Then Hamas attacked. The brothers attempted to escape; Guy decided to go with his friends while Gal headed back to his own car. Gal got stuck in a traffic jam and ditched his car, looking for a place to hide. Gal ran for hours, hiding in bushes, a bamboo field and behind trees until he was rescued by security forces. Within several hours, their family found a video of Guy and Eviatar being taken hostage in Gaza, with footage of them tied up, laying in a tunnel. His friends Idan Hermati and Ron Zarfati were murdered. "In hindsight, I know that Guy's video in the tunnel (in Gaza) was already released at 11:30 a.m., but they preferred not to update me until I got home. I don't really remember anything from when we were rescued; I didn't say anything to them, I didn't care anymore. I only thought about my brother. I went to the festival for him, I only cared about him. I couldn't bear to think about the fact I went there for him and now I'm back without him. I arrived at my parents' home, they hugged me, and I started crying." On April 6th, Pope Francis marked the six-month anniversary of the attack with an hourlong audience with relatives of the hostages, including Gal Gilboa-Dalal and his mother, Meirav Gilboa-Dalal. It was the second time the Pope has met with relatives of the hostages.
