- [Day 252: Hamas Hostage Profile: Bar Kupershtein \(22\)](#)



When Hamas terrorists launched a massive surprise assault on Israel on October 7, Bar Kupershtein, a Supernova festival staff member and paramedic, stayed behind to care for the wounded until the last moment — when the terrorists took him hostage.

Bar was working as a guard at the festival to earn money as the primary financial support for his mother and father, Julie, and Tal, and four younger siblings. His disabled father, also a paramedic, was severely injured about three years ago while assisting at a car accident.

“He is a people person, a family person. He loves to be loved, and he is the pride of the family,” said Itzhak Tabatchnik, Kupershtein’s cousin. Another family member who asked not to be named described Kupershtein as “the kind of person who will stop and help change a person’s flat tire, even when he’s dressed all in white.”

Shay Levinson, 19, from Giv’at Avni in northern Israel, was a top volleyball player and played for years with the team in Eilabun, an Arab village near his hometown. For several years, he was the only Israeli Jew on the team and strongly believed in coexistence.

On the 7th of October Levinson served in the 7th Armored Brigade’s 77th Battalion, and his body was taken hostage from the Nahal Oz area, following a battle with terrorists during the Hamas onslaught. His family doesn’t wish the other soldiers risk their lives to recover Shay remains, however they are waiting for his release to return home for a burial.
